Motion made by Supervisor Abranovich and seconded by Supervisor Dean to accept the minutes of the November 15<sup>th</sup> regular meeting without correction. All in favor. Motion carried.

Treasurer's report for November was given. Motion made by Supervisor Dean, seconded by Supervisor Hall to pay current bills, payroll and all incoming regular bills. All in favor. Motion carried.

The November police report was read by Lt. **Old Business:** Supervisor Dean moved to accept the 2022 proposed budget which had been publicly posted and advertised. Supervisor Hall seconded the motion. All in favor. Motion carried.

**New Business:** Supervisor Hall made a motion to approve that Marshall Tree Experts perform select tree cutting along County Line Road in January 2022 for the sum of \$1,950.00. The trees selected were either dead Ash trees or trees that were leaning over the roadway. Motion was seconded by Supervisor Dean. All in favor. Motion carried.

Supervisor Hall advised that the winter truck fleet has been readied for snowfall and that the Township salt shed is stocked.
