Motion to accept the May meeting minutes without correction was made by Supervisor Hall and seconded by Supervisor Fabian. All in favor. Motion carried.

The May Treasurer’s Report and bill summaries were read. Motion to pay the current bills, payroll and all incoming, regular bills was made by Supervisor Fabian. Seconded by Supervisor Hall. All in favor. Motion carried.

Old Business: Bids were opened for proposed 2022 road work consisting of the following:

1. Road maintenance: Double bituminous seal coat (tar & chip) entire length of Rogers and Bodziach Roads; and
2. Road Projects: Pave entire length of Sunview Road; pave roughly 1/3 of Rogers Road; and eight (8) paving patches over stormwater pipes/drainage measures on Sunview Drive, Rogers Road, Bowden Road and Bodziach Road. Three (3) bids were timely received and thus eligible for consideration as follows:

New Business: The final Solar Ordinance was presented by Solicitor Medure to the Board of Supervisors. Supervisor Hall made a motion to introduce the Solar Ordinance as presented. Motion was seconded by Supervisor Fabian. All in favor. Motion carried. The Solar Ordinance will be presented to the Hickory Township Planning Commission and Lawrence County Planning Commission.

Supervisor Hall made a motion to approve the tax exoneration of John Owens in accordance with Lawrence County Tax Assessment Resolution #36868 dated May 4, 2022. Motion was seconded by Supervisor Fabian. All in favor. Motion carried.

Supervisor Hall made a motion to adopt Resolution 2022-7 to proceed with an Application for County Aid. Motion was seconded by Supervisor Fabian. All in favor. Motion carried.

Supervisor Fabian made a motion to hire David M. Viggiano as a patrolman for the Hickory Township Police Department. Motion was seconded by Supervisor Hall. All in favor. Motion carried.

Supervisor Hall made a motion to appoint Michael P. Schlemmer to the Vacancy Board to fulfill the remainder of Jason Houston's term. Motion was seconded by Supervisor Fabian. All in favor. Motion carried.
