**New Business:** Supervisor Dean made a motion to increase the SALDO Application fee to include reimbursement of any engineering fees/costs incurred by the Township. The initial SALDO Application fee will remain \$200.00 and engineering fees/costs will be billed to the applicant, if applicable. Motion was seconded by Supervisor Hall. All in favor. Motion carried.

Supervisor Hall made a motion to approve Resolution #2025-5 authorizing Supervisor Fabian to sign the *UPMC Health Plan Annual Employer Group Agreement for Hickory Township* and related insurance renewal documents. Motion was seconded by Supervisor Dean. All in favor. Motion carried.

Supervisor Hall made a motion to approve Resolution #2025-6 adopting a Right-To-Know Policy. Motion was seconded by Supervisor Dean. All in favor. Motion carried.

The Lawrence County Fair requested Special Occasion Permit approval letters to sell alcohol at 2025 events held at the Lawrence County Fairgrounds. Supervisor Hall made a motion to issue approval letters for the following events: Lights Fest on Saturday May 31<sup>st</sup>; and the Annual Lawrence County Fair week from August 11<sup>th</sup>–16<sup>th</sup>. Motion was seconded by Supervisor Dean. All in favor. Motion carried.

The Coachmen Club requested a Special Occasion Permit approval letter to sell alcohol at their annual gun raffle event at the Lawrence County Fairgrounds on June 21, 2025. Supervisor Fabian made a motion to issue the approval letter as requested. Motion was seconded by Supervisor Hall. All in favor. Motion carried.

The Township tractor is down needing a transmission overhaul. The transmission repair quote is \$27,800.00. With the tractor down, the Township is unable to broom roadways to clear winter antiskid materials or mow vegetation from the roadsides. The Supervisors intend to view what used equipment is posted on Municibid. Supervisor Fabian made a motion to authorize Supervisor Hall to register as a bidder on Municibid. Motion was seconded by Supervisor Dean. All in favor. Motion carried. Supervisor Dean made a motion to set the bid limit for a used tractor w/boom mower, broom and ditch attachments at \$140,000.00. Motion seconded by Supervisor Hall. All in favor. Motion carried.

Supervisor Fabian made a motion to approve renting a broom to clear the roadways of winter antiskid materials from Sunbelt Rentals, Inc. in the amount of \$1,669.28 per week. Sunbelt Rentals, Inc. is a confirmed COSTARS vendor. Motion seconded by Supervisor Dean. All in favor. Motion carried.

Supervisor Hall made the motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:13 P.M. Motion seconded by Supervisor Fabian. All in favor. Motion carried.
