The regular monthly meeting of the Hickory Township Board of Supervisors held at the Hickory Township Municipal Building was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Chairman, Michael E. Hall.

Motion to accept the minutes of the January 3<sup>rd</sup> reorganization and regular meetings without correction was made by Supervisor Fabian and seconded by Supervisor Dean. All in favor. Motion carried.

Treasurer’s report for January was read. Motion to pay the current bills, payroll and all incoming regular bills was made by Supervisor Dean, seconded by Supervisor Fabian. All in favor. Motion carried.

Report of Police Activities for January was offered by Chief Cook. There were 30 total incidents noted which were comprised of the following: 1 abandoned vehicle; 2 administrative; 1 false alarm; 1 assist – medical; 3 assists – police department; 2 attempts to locate; 1 crash non-reportable; 1 criminal mischief; 1 erratic driver; 1 overdose; 8 property checks; 1 roadway obstruction; 1 traffic arrest; 4 traffic warnings; 1 vehicle maintenance; and 1 welfare check.

**New Business:** Motion was made by Supervisor Dean to pass Resolution 2023-7 permitting Hickory Township to enter into the annual agreement with Infocon Corp. to prepare the 2023 tax bills and authorizing Supervisor Hall to sign the Agreement. Motion was seconded by Supervisor Fabian. All in favor. Motion carried.

Richard Christopher’s Subdivision #2 – Final Plan was submitted for review and approval. Said Plan had been reviewed and approved by the Planning Commission on January 19, 2023. Supervisor Dean made a motion to accept said Plan. Supervisor Fabian seconded the motion. All in favor. Motion carried.

Supervisor Fabian made a motion to rescind Resolution #2023-6 regarding the purchase of a 2020 Ford Explorer for the police department. Supervisor Dean seconded the motion. All in favor. Motion carried.

The Board of Supervisors considered Ricky Trinidad’s request for a full refund of a Special Exception application fee. Mr. Trinidad stated that he had withdrawn his Special Exception application. However, Mr. Trinidad’s application was considered and a ruling was made. Mr. Trinidad withdrew his appeal of the decision on his application. He did not withdraw his application. The Township incurred legal fees and expenses to provide a decision to Mr. Trinidad. Supervisor Dean made a motion to deny the request for a refund. Motion was seconded by Supervisor Fabian. All in favor. Motion carried.

Motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:08 P.M. was made by Supervisor Dean and seconded by Supervisor Hall. All in favor. Motion carried.
